

What should you expect from your new lashes

Eyelash extensions need careful maintenance, and would not suite those who are very sporty. However, you can swim, wash, sweat and sleep with them in without any inconvenience.

Eyelash extensions can last up to two months or more. Touch-ups are recommended after initial full set application to replace any eyelashes that may have fallen off. Depending on your own natural eyelash growth cycle and how well you follow the after care instructions, you will probably need a touch-up every 2 to 5 weeks. Those who have a faster eyelash growth cycle may need a touch-up every 2 to 4 weeks. Those with a slower eyelash growth cycle may not need a touch-up for up to 5 weeks.

Extensions General information

- Eyelash extensions are not glued to your eyelid but the root of your own lashes.
- They do not feel fake or heavy.
- If you opt for a length too long they will fall out.
- Do not rub too hard when cleansing, use a cotton bud with a gel cleanser.

Eyelash Extensions Care Guide



Before your eyelash extension installation, you should:

- Make sure that your face has been thoroughly washed.
- You have removed all makeup.
- You have cleansed your eyes with a water-based product and not oil.
- Make sure that you have removed contact lenses.

Eyelash Extension do's and don'ts

Once your new eyelash extensions are installed, it is important that you adhere to the following instructions for the first 24 to 48 hours:

- Do not get your eyelashes wet for at least 24 hours to allow the adhesive to completely dry.
- Do not steam your face or take a steam bath.
- Do not swim.
- Do not wash your face with hot water.
- Most importantly, try not to rub eyes, as this will cause the lashes to fall out.
- Do not attempt to remove them yourself as this will cause damage to your natural lashes.

Part of good maintenance is a neat appearance. Gently using an eyelash brush will help improve the look and length of the natural lashes as well as the lash extensions. Additionally, it will keep lashes and extensions from clumping or sticking together.

Oil-based beauty products should not be used around the eyes while you are wearing extensions. This includes makeup, makeup remover, skin creams, and cleansers. These will interfere with the bonding and cause the eyelash extensions to fall out.

Mascara

The best thing about eyelash extensions is that you no longer need to use mascara to add length or volume to your lashes.

If you feel the need to use any mascara use only water based (NOT waterproof!), as any other will affect the bonds between your lashes and the extensions. Constant use of mascara may shorten the lifespan of your eyelash extensions.

Do not apply the mascara from root to tip, but on the base, bottom of lashes roughly once a week.

Do not attempt to curl your new lashes, as you will not only break the extensions, but your own lashes too.
